Las Vegans Invited to Water Forum at UWC-USA

Members of the public are invited to a free and open forum on local water issues taking place on Saturday, April 19. The forum starts at 9am. It is being co-sponsored by Luna Community College, the Las Vegas Community Water Board, and United World College-USA, and will take place in the UWC's Kluge Auditorium.

Andy Feldman of the Las Vegas City Council and Reese Fullerton, New Mexico's Deputy Cabinet Secretary for the Energy, Minerals & Natural Resources Department, will deliver the welcome and keynote address at 9am.

The day will involve small group work and workshops on Water Conservation; Agricultural, Industrial & Residential Water Use; and Coordinated Local and State Water Management. There will also be a general discussion forum.

The day will end with a celebratory concert at 7pm by singer/songwriter activist Carrie Newcomer whose work has been praised in *Rolling Stone*, *The Village Voice*, *USA Today*, *The Wall Street Journal*, *Acoustic Guitar*, and *Performing Songwriter*.
