Part of a global network of 18 schools in the UWC movement, UWC-USA enrolls idealistic students who deeply care about today's major global challenges. About 25% of the 200+ students are from the US, while the other 75% represent roughly 80 countries from every region of the world. From the moment they arrive, students enhance their international and intercultural understanding, challenge themselves academically and personally, and engage in community service driven by practical idealism.


Admissions

Most applicants are nominated through a competitive selection process in their home countries. UWC national committees exist in over 150 countries and are composed of educational leaders and UWC alumni. Students nominated by national committees receive need-based scholarships funded by UWC-USA. Candidates are assessed based on 7 criteria: intellectual curiosity and motivation, active commitment, social competence, resilience, personal responsibility, and integrity, as well as support for UWC values.

The UWC-USA Experience

All students at UWC-USA are enrolled in the full International Baccalaureate (IB) Diploma Program. In addition to their IB coursework and trimester achievements, students also earn the UWC-USA High School Diploma, graduating with both qualifications. In addition to the academic qualifications students complete requirements for Querencia, Capstone and Basecamp.

Academics: International Bacccalaureate Diploma Program

All UWC-USA students transfer from other schools, bringing at least two years of high school education in language, literature, humanities, science, math, arts, and physical education. While pursuing the IB Diploma, students also fulfill New Mexico's high school requirements by completing 2 years each of English, Math, Science, and Social Studies, along with 1 year of a non-English language at UWC.

Querencia (formerly Creativity, Activity & Service)

UWC-USA's Querencia program underscores a commitment to place-based learning, encouraging students to nurture a sense of home in northern New Mexico. Through three signature programs—Arts and Culture, Wilderness Programs, and Community Engagement—students pursue their passions, whether staging performances, leading backpacking trips, or volunteering in local schools. These activities foster leadership, peer empowerment, and practical skills, with students contributing over 17,000 hours of community service annually across the region.

Residential Life: Capstone and Basecamp

UWC-USA is a residential school where all students live on campus, building connections with peers from around the world. A core aspect of residential life is student leadership, with second-year students trained by experienced staff to take on roles in multiple support systems and student governance. Residential life emphasizes personal, communal, and integrated sustainability and is a required element of the UWC-USA experience. The structure ensures students receive support while also playing a key role in shaping their community.

Student Leadership Opportunities

- Wilderness Leaders Trained in wilderness skills and first aid to serve as mentors and guides. Students volunteer to be Wilderness Leaders.
- Resident Assistants (RAs) empower students to build a supportive, productive school community. Students must apply for leadership roles and undergo a rigorous selection process by faculty and peers. RAs are divided into 4 groups:
 - Student Wellness Education and Empowerment Team (SWEET) Resource for peers to improve mental or physical wellness
 - Climate Action Team (CAT) Examines ways to minimize the school's environmental impact
 - Constructive Transformation Team (CTT) Trained to defuse conflicts between roommates or peer groups
 - Inclusion, Diversity, Equity and Access (IDEA) Work to ensure all students feel a sense of belonging
- StuCo: Students are selected for Student Council by their peers through a democratic process. StuCo is organized by the following geographic regions at UWC-USA:
 - · AFCAR (Africa and the Caribbean)
 - PAND (Pacific and Indian Subcontinent)
 - MIND (Middle East)
 - NAD (North America)
 - · Latin America (Latin and South America)
 - END (Europe)


Class of '25 SAT Scores




Class of '25 GPA Distribution




Class of '25 Financial Aid

University Application Limit Policy



The purpose of the application limit is to ensure quality over quantity and encourage students to remain focused on their UWC experience and the rigid second year of the IB Diploma. University admissions officers should be confident that any application received from a UWC student is a serious application.
